Proposed amendment by Cr Marija Vujcic

To amend part 2 of the officer's recommendation, as follows:

OFFICER'S RECOMMENDATION

Council:

1. Supports in principle the interpretative concept **RESPECT, RECOGNITION AND RECONCILIATION** by Sharyn Egan and Simon Gilby for Kings Square as outlined in Attachment 1, noting that it integrates an interpretation of the location of the former St John's Church as well as Nyoongar culture;
2. Notes that the following aspects will be progressed to develop the concept:
 - a. Integrating the interpretative paving for the former church as part of the planned enhancement works around the Walyalup Civic Centre;
 - b. Re-instating the plaque that explains the location of the former church building; Agenda - Strategic Planning and Transport Committee 18 November 2020 Page 7
 - c. Engagement with traditional owners from 14 Nyoongar clans, seeking initial advice from the South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council;
 - d. Concept design development;
 - e. Presentation to the City's WRAP Reference Group;
 - f. Development of a cost plan and identification of potential funding partners;
 - g. *the city's history in the interpretative art to be inclusive, and diverse to include all history and that there is equity in representational outcome;*
 - h. *that there is, in addition to WRAP, several representative groups also included in the dialogue.*
3. Requests that a further report be presented back to Council to provide an update on matters in Items 2 c, d, e and f, above.

Reason for change:

To ensure inclusivity and diversity in the development of the concept.
