



Children's Library and Gaming Zone Guidelines:

The following guidelines must be observed by children, youth, guardians, and other patrons while visiting Fremantle Library.

- Children aged 12 years and younger must be accompanied by a responsible guardian over the age of 18 years. The guardian must supervise children in the library and are responsible for the monitoring of their behaviour and activities.
- Children aged 5 years and younger must always be within sight of their guardian. More information on supervision of children in the library can be found in the Supervision of Children Guidelines document on our website.
- Furniture (chairs, stools, beanbags) are not allowed in the nook at the top of the slide or on the slide.
- The children's area is reserved for children aged 12 and younger and their guardians. Youth and adults should not sit in this area.
- The gaming zone is reserved for children and youth and their guardians (where applicable) after 3pm during school term and at all times during school holidays. Adults sitting in this area should relocate to other parts of the library during these times.
